What access does it provide?

- The EMPIRE PASS provides unlimited day-use vehicle entry to most facilities operated by New York State Parks and the State Dept. of Environmental Conservation including forests, beaches, trails and more.
- Guidelines for use and Information on covered sites are available on the New York Parks and Recreation Website: parks.ny.gov. You'll find covered sites under the "Visit" tab.

What restrictions apply?

- The EMPIRE PASS does not guarantee parking when the park is at maximum capacity. Parking is available on a first-come, first-served basis and does not allow for early entry prior to park hours.
- The EMPIRE PASS does not guarantee free vehicle entry into the park when special events occur and are operated by other organizations.
- The EMPIRE PASS does not include waiver of fees for camping, golf, museum or historic site admission. Special activity fees are not included.
- The EMPIRE PASS is usable for all motor vehicles except those used in the business of transporting passengers for hire including public or private buses, shuttles, taxis, limousines, or other livery vehicles.
- The EMPIRE PASS must be presented upon entry to the facility. Without the pass, you will be required to pay the vehicle entry fee.

How do I get information on covered parks and historic sites?

- Follow the "Visit" tab on the New York Parks and Recreation Website: parks.ny.gov.

Can I reserve the pass in advance?

- If all passes are currently in use, you can place a hold and you will be notified when a pass becomes available.
- Once notified, you will have 5 days to claim your turn with the pass before the pass is given to the next patron on the list and you lose your place in line.

How long can I borrow it for?

- You may borrow this item for one week.

Can I renew this item?

- As long as there are no holds placed on this item, you may renew it one time.

What is the replacement cost of this item?

- \$80

BORROWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

BORROWERS must be adult Three Village residents who hold an Emma Clark Library card in good standing.

The late fine for a borrowed pass is \$1 per day (up to a maximum of \$10). Borrowers will be billed for the full replacement cost for any pass that is kept more than 14 days past the due date. ITEMS WITH HOLDS ARE NOT RENEWABLE.

As with other library materials, once you have checked out the pass, you are responsible for its care and that of any supplemental materials included with it. If any of the library's property is lost or damaged, it will be your responsibility to pay the full replacement cost.
